1	pile on	[동] To put a large amount of something onto something else; To quickly jump on top of a person or a group of people
2	engaging	[형] Charming and attractive in a way that holds your interest; Very interesting and keeping your attention
3	mild	[형] Not severe, serious, or harsh; Gentle and calm in temperament or behavior
4	developer	[명] A person or company that creates and designs computer software or applications; A person or business that buys land and builds houses or offices on it
5	engagement	[명] A formal agreement or promise to get married; An arrangement to meet someone or do something at a fixed time
6	parameter	[명] A rule or limit that controls how something should be done; A measurable factor that defines a system or sets the conditions of its operation
7	unfortunately	[부] Used to say that something is sad, disappointing, or bad luck; By bad luck; in an unlucky manner
8	outcome	[명] The final result or effect of an action, process, or situation; Something that follows as a consequence of an event
9	dynamic	[형] Full of energy, enthusiasm, and new ideas; Characterized by constant change, activity, or progress [명] A force that stimulates change or progress within a system; The way in which people behave and interact with each other
10	instructional	[형] Designed or used for teaching and education; Providing detailed directions on how to do or use something
11	Resist	[동] To fight against something or someone that is attacking or pressure you; To remain undamaged or unaffected by a force or substance [명] A coating applied to a surface to protect it from corrosion, chemicals, or damage during a process; A substance used in dyeing and printing to prevent color from sticking to certain areas
12	Focus	[명] the centre of interest or activity; a center of activity, attraction, or attention [동] adapt to the prevailing level of light and become able to see clearly; to cause to be directed at something specific
13	incorporate	[동] To include something as a part of a larger group or system; To combine different things together to form a single whole
14	temptation	[명] A strong desire to do something, especially something wrong or unwise; Something that attracts or entices someone to do something
15	achievement	[명] Something done successfully, especially through hard work or skill; The act or process of completing something successfully
16	design	[명] A drawing or plan that shows how something will look and work before it is made; The way in which something has been planned and made [동] To plan and make decisions about the look and function of something; To create or construct something according to a detailed plan
17	interactivity	[명] The quality of allowing two-way flow of information between a computer and a user; The state of two or more people or things working together and influencing each other
18	entertaining	[형] Providing amusement or enjoyment; Interesting and keeping your attention in a pleasant way

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19	forestry	[명] the science or practice of planting, managing, and caring for forests; The science of planting and growing trees in forests
20	agriculture	[명] The science, art, or practice of cultivating soil, producing crops, and raising livestock; The occupation or business of farming to provide food, wool, and other products
21	highest	[형] Located at the greatest distance above the ground or base; Greatest in amount, degree, or intensity [부] At or to the most elevated point or level; To the greatest degree or extent
22	fishing	[명] The activity or sport of catching fish; The business or industry of catching fish and other seafood for sale
23	percentage point	[명] A unit of arithmetic difference between two percentages; The unit used when subtracting one percentage from another [속어] The unit for the arithmetic difference between two percentages; A unit equal to one percent, used to measure changes in rates or proportions
24	hunting	[명] The activity of chasing and killing wild animals for food or sport; The act of searching carefully for a particular thing or person [형] Used for, relating to, or associated with the sport of chasing and killing wild animals; Fond of or actively engaged in the sport of chase
25	percentage	[명] A rate, number, or amount in each hundred; A portion or share of a whole
26	gap	[명] A space or opening between two objects or people; A difference, especially an undesirable one, between two views, situations, or groups
27	lowest	[형] Being below all others in level, position, or height; Being the least in amount, value, or intensity
28	arise	[동] To begin to occur or to exist; To result or originate from a source
29	unfair	[형] Not treating people equally or in a reasonable way; Not following the rules or standards of a game, sport, or competition
30	threatening	[형] Having a hostile or frightening quality that suggests harm or danger; Showing an intention to cause bodily harm or damage
31	empowering	Giving someone more confidence and control over their life; Making a person feel strong, capable, and in charge of their destiny
32	fascinating	[형] Extremely interesting and keeping your attention; Having a powerful appeal or charm
33	overwhelmed	[형] Feeling completely overcome in mind or feeling by a large amount of something; Having too many things to deal with at one time
34	trigger	[명] A small lever that is pulled to fire a gun; An event or situation that causes something else to happen [동] To cause an event or situation to happen suddenly; To make a device or system start functioning
35	define	[동] To state or explain the precise meaning of a word or phrase; To describe or show the essential qualities or nature of something
36	random	[형] Chosen or happening without a specific plan, pattern, or purpose; Having an unpredictable outcome where all possibilities are equally likely
37	examine	[동] To look at something closely and carefully in order to learn more about it; To check the health or physical condition of someone

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38	suppress	[동] To put an end to something by force; To prevent the expression or revelation of something
39	judgment	[명] The ability to make considered decisions or come to sensible conclusions; A formal decision given by a court of law
40	devastated	[형] Feeling extremely shocked, sad, and overwhelmed by a painful event; Completely ruined, destroyed, or laid to waste
41	insight	[명] The capacity to gain an accurate and deep understanding of someone or something; The ability to understand people and situations in a very clear way
42	criticize	[동] To express disapproval of someone or something by pointing out their faults; To evaluate or analyze a work of art, literature, or performance
43	perceive	[동] To notice or become aware of something through the senses; To understand or think of something in a particular way
44	interpret	[동] To explain or clarify the meaning of something; To understand or take something in a particular way
45	worth	[형] Having a specific value, especially in terms of money; Deserving of some action, effort, or attention [명] The level at which someone or something deserves to be valued or rated; The amount of something that has a specified value or lasts for a specified time
46	serve	[동] To provide food or drink to someone; To help customers in a shop or restaurant [명] An act of hitting a ball or shuttlecock to start a game or point in sports like tennis or volleyball; The turn or right of a player to hit the ball to start play
47	conclude	[동] To decide or form an opinion after thinking about the facts; To bring something to an end or finish it
48	widespread	[형] Existing or happening in many places or among many people; Spread over a large area
49	publish	[동] To prepare and produce a book, magazine, or other material for public sale or distribution; To make information or an announcement known to the general public
50	theory	[명] An idea or set of ideas that explains why something happens or how something works; A set of principles on which a particular subject or activity is based
51	accept	[동] To agree to receive something willingly; To acknowledge or admit something as valid
52	map	[명] A visual representation of an area showing physical features, cities, or roads; A drawing of the earth's surface or a part of it on a flat sheet [동] To make a map of an area; To plan the details of something carefully
53	confirm	[동] To prove that something is true or correct; To state with certainty that something has happened or will happen
54	objection	[명] An expression or feeling of disapproval or opposition; A reason for disagreeing with or opposing something
55	mathematician	[명] An expert or specialist in the field of mathematics; A person who studies, teaches, or does research in mathematics
56	development	[명] The process of growing, progressing, or becoming more advanced; The act or process of creating or building something over a period of time
57	discover	[동] To find something unexpectedly or during a search; To learn or find out about something for the first time

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58	telescope	[명] A tube-shaped optical instrument used to make distant objects appear closer and larger; An astronomical device that collects light to observe stars and planets [동] To slide or cause to slide into itself so that it becomes shorter; To become forced together lengthwise, with one part entering another, as during a collision
59	observe	[동] To watch carefully in order to learn about something; To notice or perceive something happening
60	travel	[동] To go from one place to another, especially over a long distance; To move or be transmitted from one point to another [명] The act or activity of going from one place to another, especially over a long distance; A journey or trip, especially to a distant or unfamiliar destination [형] Designed, suitable, or convenient for use while traveling; Made in a compact size to be easily carried during a trip
61	universe	[명] All of space and everything in it, including stars, planets, and galaxies; A particular sphere of activity, interest, or experience
62	revolutionary	[형] Involving or causing a complete or dramatic change in something; Relating to, involving, or supporting a political revolution [명] A person who starts or supports a political revolution; Someone who wants to change a political system by force
63	movement	[명] The act or process of changing physical location or position; A series of organized activities by a group of people to achieve a social or political goal
64	advance	[동] To move forward in a purposeful way; To make progress or develop [명] A forward movement toward a goal or target; An improvement or development in a particular area [형] Completed or provided before a certain time or event; Sent or done ahead of schedule
65	crater	[명] A large bowl-shaped cavity in the ground, typically caused by an explosion or an impact; The bowl-shaped depression or mouth of a volcano [동] To form craters or hollow depressions in a surface; To fail or fall suddenly and dramatically
66	astronomer	[명] A scientist who studies stars, planets, and other celestial bodies; An expert who observes and analyzes space and the physical universe
67	emergence	[명] The process of becoming visible or known after being hidden; The act of coming into existence or becoming prominent
68	norm	[명] An accepted standard or a pattern of social behavior that is typical or expected; Something that is usual, common, or standard
69	barrier	[명] A physical structure or obstacle that prevents movement or access; A rule, problem, or situation that makes it difficult to do something
70	prescriptive	[형] Giving strict rules or instructions on how things must be done; Telling people how language should be used based on rules
71	influence	[명] The power to change or affect someone or something; The capacity to have an effect on the character or development of someone [동] To have an effect on the character, development, or behavior of someone or something; To affect or change something in an indirect but significant way
72	conform	[동] To behave according to socially acceptable rules or standards; To obey or comply with rules, laws, or regulations

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73	legitimize	[동] To make something legal or acceptable; To give official status or approval to something
74	transmit	[동] To send or convey something from one person, place, or thing to another; To broadcast a signal or information using radio waves, wires, or the internet
75	dominate	[동] To have control, power, or authority over someone or something; To be the most important, noticeable, or conspicuous feature of something
76	enforce	[동] To make sure that a law or rule is obeyed; To force something to happen or be accepted
77	strict	[형] Demanding that rules concerning behavior are obeyed; Must be obeyed, leaving no room for changes or excuses
78	platform	[명] A raised flat surface where people can stand, perform, or speak; The area beside railway tracks where passengers get on and off trains [동] To place someone or something on a stage or a raised surface; To provide a public voice or opportunity for someone to express their views
79	background	[명] The part of a picture or scene that is furthest from the viewer, behind the main objects; A person's education, experience, and social circumstances [동] To form a background to something; To provide with background information or context [형] Relating to things that are less important or less noticeable; Occurring in the rear of a scene or setting
80	slang	[명] Very informal words and phrases that are more common in spoken than written English; Special vocabulary used by a specific group of people that may not be understood by outsiders
81	fundamentally	[부] At the most basic or essential level; In a way that affects the most important parts of something
82	democratize	[동] To introduce a democratic system or principles to a country or organization; To make something accessible or available to everyone
